The S2P Automation Integration leads continuous improvement projects with the aim of increasing the effectiveness and efficiency of the end-to-end process focusing on generating opportunities for cross-divisional standardization.

- Responsible for all solution design documentation related to automation projects.
- Test automations with process SMEs and stakeholders
- Ensure successful deployment of automations into production without impacting existing automations and operations.
- Provide support on production automations.
- Translate conceptual "to-be" business process into technical design
- Recommend best-fit technology for each automations use case
